Marie Rohlfs Detachment 157 Assistance Fund-The Det 157 Family Helping Cadets in Need

Background: This fund was established by Det 157 family members and supporters as a way to recognize the spirit of Ms. Marie Rohlfs' incredible personal contributions supporting cadets in her service to the Det. 157 family for well over 40 years. Donors see this as a way to give back to an organization that has been meaningful in their lives. The Fund is meant to help current cadets who have encountered a dire financial hardship. It is a safety net designed to provide such help when no other means are available to meet the need in the time frame required.

This is a self-renewing fund meaning recipients of this fund should commit to paying these funds back after commissioning when their finances permit. This, along with other donations, will allow us to continue taking care of our own by ensuring funds will be available for future cadets facing similar financial hardships.

This fund, to the extent monies are available, will be awarded to qualified cadets to pay for situations including, but not limited to, unexpected hardships such as medical expenses, bereavement expenses, essential clothing, and/or essential transportation. This fund cannot be used to pay for educational expenses including tuition, fees, room and board, textbooks or other fees associated with the cost of an Embry-Riddle education. Likewise, payments for ongoing expenses like rent, food, transportation, etc. are not permitted.

Repayment is handled on an honor basis. No follow-up will ever be made from the Detachment or the school for repayment. Repayment information is provided on the last page of this document.

Qualification Criteria:

- □ Applicant must submit a written request using this application; available from Det. 157.
- □ Applicant must be enrolled at the Embry-Riddle Daytona Beach Campus as a full-time undergraduate or graduate student, making satisfactory progress toward any degree offered.
- □ Applicant must be a current cadet in good standing in the Air Force Det. 157 ROTC program.
- □ Applicant must have encountered a (documented) situation requiring financial assistance which cannot be addressed in the time needed by other available means.
- □ Disbursement of funds cannot exceed \$1,500.00 per recipient per academic year.
- □ Financial assistance may be awarded to the same cadet in future semesters within the confines of the above criteria.

Directions: Print and complete all four pages of this document. Then, bring them to the detachment and hand it directly to the Air Force Det 157 Administrative Assistant who will review the application for completeness. Once accepted, the needed coordination will take place and you will be notified as soon as possible on the status of your application. If approved, money will be disbursed to you in the form of financial aid from the school. For this reason, it's recommended that you have direct deposit set up in order to expedite the disbursement process.
